



Guest Day Pass Policy

LifeQuest Fitness Center, a private health club serving individuals and families in and around the Tri-Cities area for 20 years. We are pleased to announce that over the last three years our membership has doubled in size, thank you! It is our commitment to you, the member, to provide the highest quality customer service, classes, training, specialized programs and equipment. Our members mean everything to us! With this said, we are adjusting our Day Pass Policy to better serve you. The following policy will go into effect April 15, 2017.

Adult Guest Day Pass Policy

1. **Qualified adults** are permitted with a member. You, as the member are considered your guest's host. This means you must accompany your guest throughout his/her visit.
 - a. **Qualified Adult** = a guest is 18+ in age, photo identification (driver's license) and is accompanied by a member of LifeQuest Fitness.
2. Day Passes are no longer granted to the general public.
3. Guest Day Pass \$15.00

Minor Guest Day Pass Policy

1. **Qualified minors** are permitted with a **qualified member**.
 - a. **Qualified Minor** = a minor of a member of LifeQuest Fitness who is the parent or grandparent
 - b. **Qualified Member** = a member of LifeQuest Fitness who is the parent or grandparent of the visiting minor
2. All minors must be accompanied by their qualifying member at all times.
3. Members are not allowed to bring in other people's children into the facility.
4. Kids club services are granted to qualified minor only
 - a. Kids Club is a member only service. All documentation must be completed before the child is cared for by the staff. This is for the health and safety of your child, the other children and the staff in the facility.
5. Minor Guest Day Pass \$10.00

All qualified members must make an appointment with membership for their guest's visit. This visit will consist of the review of the club's policies and procedures. Failure to act in accordance with our policies may result in revoking of the guest day pass and the guest leaving the facility without a day pass refund.
