

**LifeQuest Fitness Customer Safety Protocol**  
**Phase 1 staffed water recreation facilities**

Please wear a mask when you enter the Club.

- Masks are required for everyone over the age of 2 year.
- If you are unable to wear a mask due to a medical issue, please tell the service desk attendant prior to entering the building.

Hand Sanitizer stations are located inside the lobby. Washing hands frequently is highly recommended.

6 foot distancing lines will guide you to the service desk. Please take your time and allow people in front of you to check in properly without compromising the 6 foot spacing.

Temperature check! The service desk attendant will take your temperature through an infrared thermometer. Your temperature must be below 100.4 degrees to be allowed into the building.

Swim lesson clients must sign in. Members will use their key tag to scan into our check in system.

Member swim reservations will be reviewed upon entering.

Members and swim lesson clients may choose from locker rooms or family changing rooms to get into their swim gear. Please bring a lock if you wish to use the day use lockers.

Face masks are not required in the pool or in the shower. Please put your face mask back on before you leave the building.

Please do not congregate in the pool area. Social distancing is required.

Checking out! This is new! Both members and swim clients are required to sign out as you leave the building. This will allow us to comply with the Covid-19 tracing requirements.

Lost and Found: Due to the changes in safety guidelines, LifeQuest will not keep any items that are left inside the facility. Please be careful to take all of your belongings with you as you leave the building. Clothing, water bottles and all other items will be thrown away at the end of business each day. We are sorry for any inconvenience. We must comply with safety first!
